

Technical Assistance is one of the many duties of the Traffic Safety Resource Prosecutor. The following are just some of the examples of technical assistance that the TSRP provides:

- Assist NHTSA (statistics, pilot projects, presentations, attend regional meetings, etc.)
- Assist highway safety office/grant administrator
- List serves and e-mail lists (including forums)
- DUI/DWAI Manuals
- Predicate Questions
- Training videos
- Copies of DRE, SFST/HGN, ARIDE, and DITEP Manuals
- Case law/legislative/new scientific study updates
- Sentencing charts
- Notification of classes and assistance in enrolling in SFST/DRE/ARIDE training
- *Amicus* Briefs (writing and/or soliciting)
- Second chair motion hearings and trials
- Serve on committees (e.g. POST marijuana workgroup)
- Assist fellow TSRPs
- Maintain an electronic brief bank and/or provide templates
- Collect available publications and resource guides (monographs, newsletters, etc.)
- Anything that will assist prosecutors, officers, and other traffic safety partners.
